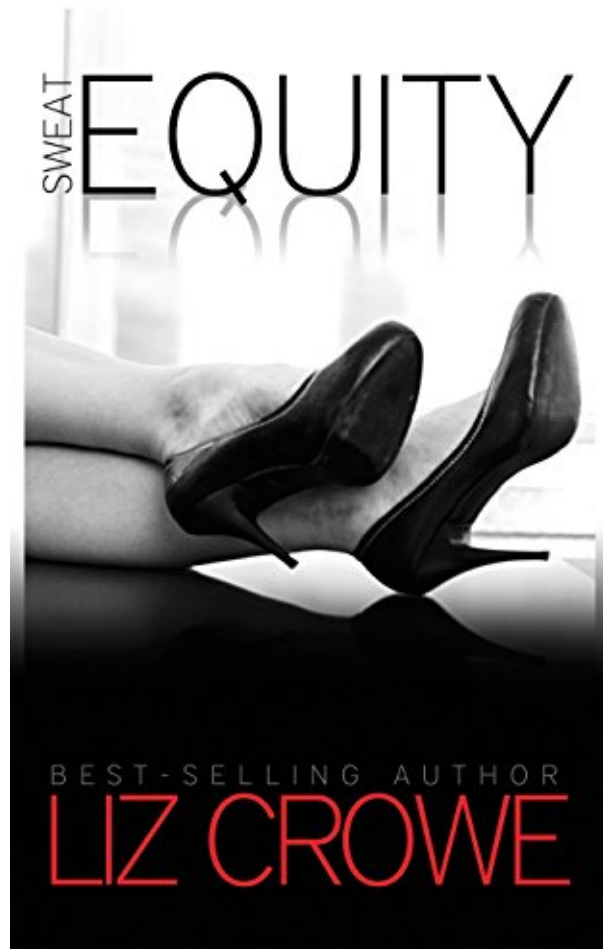
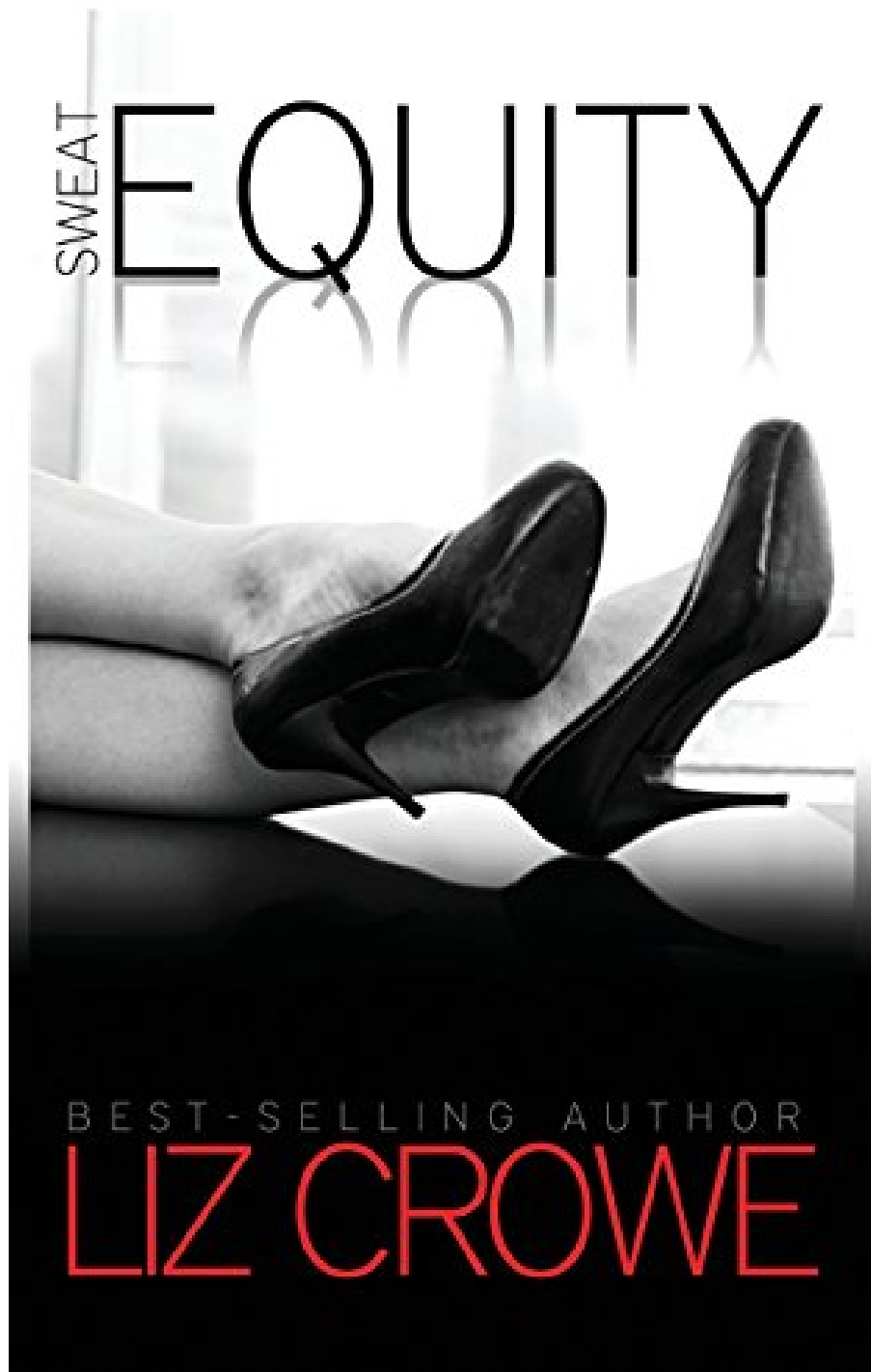

Sweat Equity is, hands down, one of my favorite reads of 2012 and has earned a much deserved 5 stars! I finished this book over a week ago and yet I still cannot find the words to accurately convey how much I loved it. Will the fact that I can't find another book to grab my attention because I'm still thinking about it, suffice? Or how about this, I've read Chapter 17, 18, the Epilogue and the sneak peek of Closing Costs - no less than 10 times since my original read. I can't get these characters out of my head! They drown in these emotions and cannot seem to get their head above water for a breath, let alone to reach for the life preserve that is their love for each other. They panic and defense mechanisms kick in. In an effort to save themselves, they push the other underneath with words and actions that will cause the most pain. They know it's wrong, but just can't stop.

The more that I read Jack's character, the more I love him. His feelings for Sara are so intense, visceral and evoke such depth, they make you want to climb into the book and become Sara just so you can feel them. Then he makes a magnificent jerk of himself and all you want to do is smack him and scream "No!!!! WTH are you doing?" His self-hatred is so great and his fear is so strong he just can't let go to love completely, it is heart-wrenching to read. My favorite Jack quote in the book:

"Like what, baby? Like that you miss me?" She started to protest but he cut her off. "Do not say a word. Just listen a minute, if you can. I miss you too, like a ***** phantom limb, do you understand? You are a crucial, functioning part of me, always will be. But I get it. I'm a *****. I won't deny.
